

APPLICATION PROCESS FOR

THE LOUISE PARKER BERRY FELLOWSHIP



All applications should include the following:

- A cover letter of no more than one page, including contact information through June 15, 2007.
- Résumé of no more than two pages
- Two essays
 - In up to 100 words, tell us “One thing I know for sure.”
 - In up to 500 words, tell us “Why I will make a difference at Darien Library.”
- No more than five references, attesting to your leadership promise, personal ethics, and commitment to the role of libraries in our society.
- Graduate school transcript
 - GRE score if required by the institution from which you will have received your MLS (may be self-reported)
- Undergraduate transcript (need not be official)

Applications are due by 5:00 pm April 6, 2007, and should be delivered to the following address:
